We would appreciate your support in helping to promote a programme of webinar, organised by Sussex Partnership NHS Foundation Trust, which are open to all parents and carers of young people in Sussex.

The mental health workshops, all led by experienced CAMHS clinicians or partner organisations will take place virtually between October 2023 and July 2024. Each webinar will be available at two different times, once during the day (10am) and once in the evening (7pm) to make it as easy as possible for people to attend, depending on their lifestyle.

The following topics for the workshops have been confirmed for February to July 2024:

Parents and carers will be able to choose to attend as many or as few as they think are appropriate for them to attend, with recordings of all webinars being made available afterwards. The sessions last for 90-120 minutes with the opportunity to ask any questions to CAMHS clinicians. Due to anticipated high numbers of attendees, any questions will need to be sent in advance.
